

b. Hearing on an application requesting a Plat of Encore Addition (Minor Subdivision) a replat of Lots 1-6, Block 1, Urban Plains Rec Facility Addition to the City of Fargo, Cass County, North Dakota. Assistant Planner Maegin Rude presented the staff report stating all approval criteria have been met and staff is recommending approval.
